## ORDER:

The Special Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has stated that in the review meeting with the Cancer and AIDS Research Units of Government Siddha Medical College, Palayamkottai and Arignar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine, Chennai held on 01-03-2001, it was decided to distribute the medicines for 15 or 30 days to AIDS / Cancer patients.

- 2) The Special Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has also stated that the Assistant Medical Officer, Government Hospital, Tambaram at Chromepet has suggested for the distribution of medicines for one week for B.P. and Diabetic patients. He has further stated that the Deputy Director, Cancer and AIDS Centre at Arignar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine, Chennai and Government Siddha Medical College, Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli have suggested distribution of medicines for 15 days for AIDS patients.
