

Job description for AYUSH Staff under NHM

I. Medical Officer

1. To treat the patients.
2. To monitor proper functioning of the wing and indenting of medicine through DSMO.
3. Maintain the OP register and other Registers with all valid information.
4. Monitor the entry in HMIS.
5. To control all the staff in dispensary working under him / her.

II. Pharmacist (Dispenser)

1. Dispensing of medicine as prescribed by Medical Officer.
2. To Maintain Main Store register.
3. To Maintain the sub store & its register.
4. To Maintain token register.
5. To Maintain consolidation register.
6. To put OP chart for patients.
7. To report to the Medical Officers (AYUSH).
8. Indenting of Medicines from the Main Store maintain availability of Medicines.

III. Therapeutic Assistant

1. To give all type of Therapies.
2. To report to the Medical Officer (AYUSH).

IV. MPHW

1. To Maintain the dispensary neat and clean in and around.
2. To Maintain Herbal Gardens.
3. Support during Camps /Stalls put in the Districts.
4. To report to the Medical Officer (AYUSH).
5. To carry over the duties assigned by the superiors.
